

AAUW – READING BRANCH GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

2010-2011

The American Association of University Women–Reading Branch has established a Graduate Scholarship Fund to annually award scholarships of up to \$2000 to Berks County women who are pursuing full or part-time graduate study. The money will be awarded for the 2010-2011 school year. Academic excellence is expected and financial need must be demonstrated.

Awards shall be made directly to the educational institution. Scholarships will be awarded only if evidence of financial need is presented to the committee. Applicant shall submit a FAFSA needs analysis form (<http://www.fafsaonline.com>)

The applicant shall provide the following documents: a completed application, a FAFSA needs analysis form, two letters of academic recommendation from faculty members of applicant's educational institution, and one non-relative character reference. Please include a transcript from your undergraduate school and, if applicable, from your graduate school. All of the above materials must be postmarked by **May 29, 2010** and sent to the address below. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Questions may be directed to donnajudd@aol.com

Verification of acceptance into an educational program will be required before money is disbursed.

All applications will be treated confidentially. Scholarship recipients' names will be published. Reapplications will be considered, although new applicants will be given priority.

Scholarship funds are raised through the annual AAUW Reading Branch/Friends of the Berks County Public Libraries Book Bonanza.
